

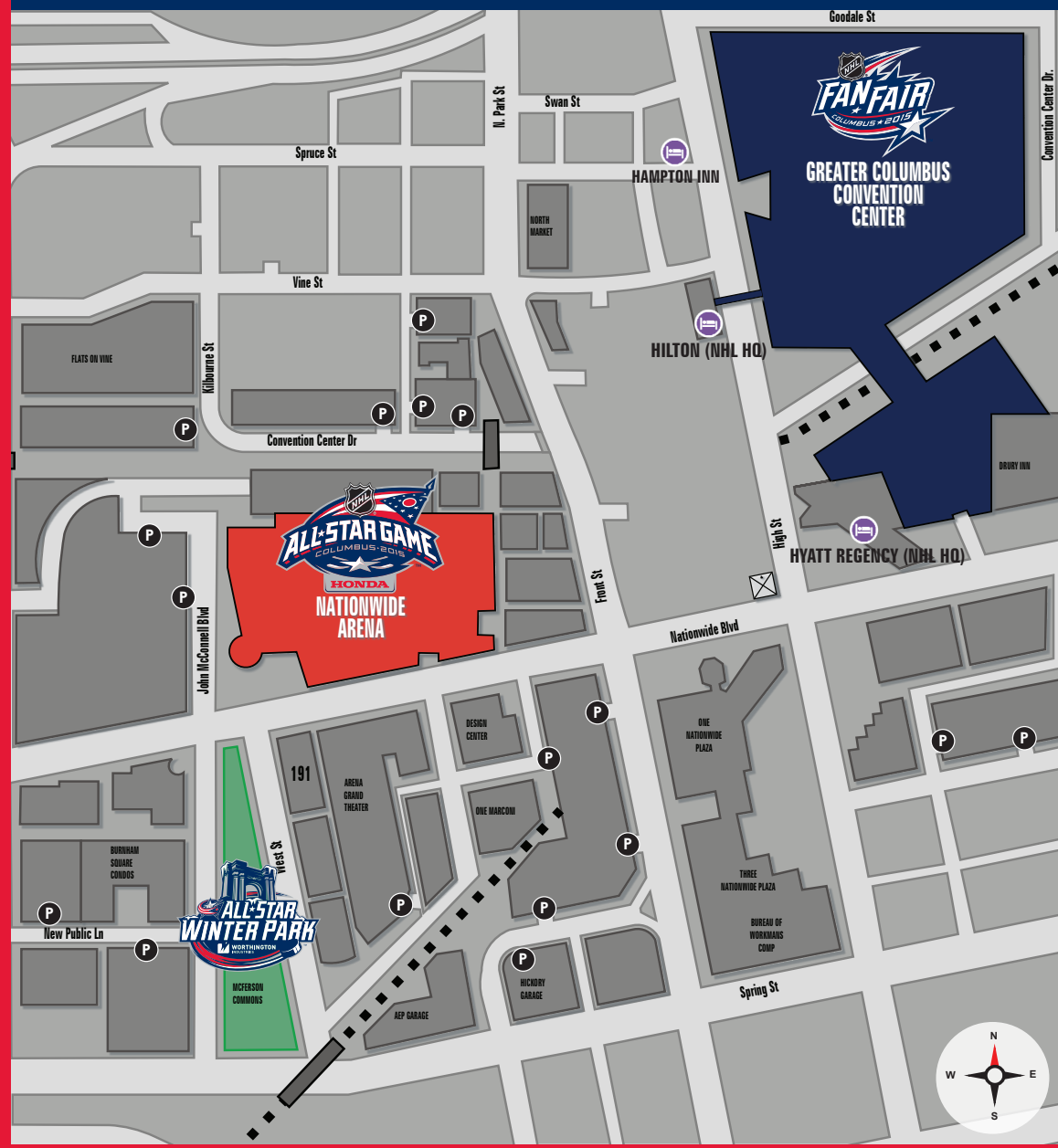

★ Hot Spots

- **Arena District** — Before the game, grab a bite from the local food hub, The North Market. Indulge in the pre- and post-game atmosphere at watering holes near Nationwide Arena like the hockey-centric R Bar or The Three-Legged Mare, and end your night clubbing along Park Street.
- **Short North** — Take in one of the nation's most envied art districts with an afternoon of unique local shopping at Tigertree, Milk Bar, and Rowe, and grab quick bites from standout restaurants like Gallerie Bar & Bistro, The Pearl, and Rigsby's. Catch a late performance at the newly restored Short North Stage, formerly a vaudeville house.
- **Downtown/German Village** — Just a few blocks south of Nationwide Arena, downtown Columbus' Gay Street is buzzing with activity. Grab a coffee (Café Brioso) or tea (ZenCha Tea Salon) and browse local shops, like Zeroz. Hop on the free CBUS downtown circulator and head 1/2 mile south to German Village, where you'll find classic dining at G. Michael's and Lindey's and find a cozy booth at Curio, one of the city's swankiest cocktail bars.
- **Easton Town Center** — A 15-minute drive east from downtown will bring you to Ohio's largest shopping center, Easton. More a neighborhood than a mall, Easton offers you national retailers like the Columbus-based Express and Victoria's Secret, luxury brands, and unique dining experiences like Mitchell's Ocean Club, Brio, and Northstar Café.
